ORDER SCHEDULING SETTLEMENT CONFERENCES

1. The second formal settlement conference in the above-captioned proceeding is scheduled to convene on Tuesday, November 19, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. EST, in a hearing room of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, N.E., Washington, D.C. 20426. This settlement conference will continue through Wednesday, November 20, 2019, until 2:00 p.m., unless otherwise ordered.
2. The third formal settlement conference in this proceeding is scheduled to convene on Thursday, December 5, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. EST, in a hearing room of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, N.E., Washington, D.C. 20426. This settlement conference will continue through Friday, December 6, 2019, until 2:00 p.m., unless otherwise ordered.

Unless otherwise authorized prior to the settlement conferences, each participant shall ensure that it has at least one (1) representative in attendance at the second and third conference with actual present authority to negotiate and accept (at least in principle) settlement terms, or with immediate access to such individuals. For those participants preferring to attend the technical conferences remotely in the Washington, D.C. area, Commission personnel will provide videoconference capabilities in hearing rooms of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, N.E., Washington, D.C. 20426. Participants planning to participate remotely from other locations should coordinate logistics with Northwestern Corporation.
